WELCOME 7TH & 8TH GRADERS TO HERITAGE ACADEMY

The following is a list of the <u>required</u> materials needed for your core classes that should be brought the first day of school. We request that each student have **one large zipper binder that will be used every day for each class.** Inside the binder you will need the following for each class:

Pencil pouch

Two black or blue pens

Two pencils (sharpened before class)

Two **erasable** red pens for editing and grading (Erasable pens are required for 7th grade English. 8th grade English can use erasable pens or red pencils. Regular red pens or pencils will work for the other classes)

College ruled loose-leaf notebook paper

Highlighters

Glue stick

In addition to the basic supplies each teacher requires the following:

Algebra I: Pencils (traditional or mechanical), Eraser, Bound Lab-Book (preferably with page numbers and grid-lines such as graph paper), THICK Dry Erase Markers (will be used by students daily all year), Colored Highlighters (at least 4 different colors), Loose Leaf Paper (college ruled NO spiral bound), Ruler, Glue Stick, Disinfectant Wipes, box of Tissues.

English 7th: 1 College ruled spiral notebook (70 count), 1-3 hole two pocket folder (no brads)

English 8th: 2 College ruled spiral notebooks (70 count), White out, begin reading *The Hobbit* if possible

<u>General Math:</u> 1" binder used *for math only*, 1 set of 5 tab dividers, Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS scientific calculator, 2 dry erase markers, small scissors, colored pencils, composition (college ruled) notebook, 2 glue sticks, graph paper. *Note: Teacher found composition notebook on sale for \$.50 and glue sticks, 2 for \$.50.* Students may pick those up from teacher on the first day of school if they would like.

<u>History 7th:</u> 3 two pocket folders (2 with brads/prongs for 3 hole punched papers) a 70 page spiral notebook just for history; one highlighter, one red pen for grading papers, one glue stick

<u>History 8th:</u> -1 two pocket folder with brads filled with lined paper, 1 composition book

Latin 7th 1/2" 3 ring binder, Dry Erase Markers, eraser for dry erase (old socks work fine), one page protector.

<u>Latin 8th:</u> 1 Pocket Folder; One two subject notebook (preferably with binder holes, so that you can insert in your binder) to be used for Latin specifically, dry erase markers, dry eraser, 2 red pens, 2 blue pens, and 1 small Latin-English/English-Latin dictionary.

Organization and Leadership: 1 spiral notebook

<u>Pre-Algebra:</u> 1" binder used *for math only*, 1 set of 5 tab dividers, 6" ruler, graph paper, jumbo size book cover, Dry Erase Markers, Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS scientific calculator *Optional – Clorox wipes

Science 7th: 1 composition notebook, 1 two pocket folder

<u>Science 8th:</u> 1 composition notebook, 1-100 sheet spiral notebook, white out, ruler, graph paper (if you are in pre-algebra, you do not need an additional ruler or set of graph paper)

An outside reading book should be carried to each class. The teacher will discuss the appropriate use of the book. This can be one from the list of classics, the library or one from home.

On the first day of class, you will be given an agenda that must be kept in your binder and taken to each class every day. Also, <u>each</u> classroom is in need of *tissues* for the runny noses that occur during the year. **Donations** of boxes of tissues are welcomed and needed.
