

JUNIOR HIGH SUPPLY LIST

The following is a list of the required materials needed for your core classes that should be brought the first day of school. We request that each student have **one large zipper binder that will be used every day for each class**. Inside the binder they will need the following for each class:

Pencil pouch
Two black or blue pens
Two pencils (sharpened before class)
Red pens
College ruled loose-leaf notebook paper
Highlighters
Glue stick

In addition to the basic supplies each teacher requires the following:

English 7th:

1. 3-ring binder which can be used to carry materials for other classes
2. Pocket folder labeled "English" for storing notes and handouts
3. College ruled loose-leaf paper in binder
4. College ruled 1-subject spiral notebook used only for English
5. Two black or blue ink pens
6. Two mechanical pencils or two wood pencils sharpened before class
7. Two erasable red pens for editing

English 8th: Bring the following every day to class:

Paper: College-ruled, loose-leaf

Binder: 3-ring binder (*may be a dedicated section in binder with dividers*)

Pens, Pencil, Highlighter: 2 sharpened pencils, 2 erasable red pens/pencils, at least 1 highlighter, 2 erasable blue or black pen, 1 dry erase marker

Notebook: 1 college-ruled SPIRAL notebook for English use only; at least 70 pages; cover should be a material that can be written on with marker

Glue Stick or Tape: Clear tape or glue stick to attach handouts into notebook

Agenda: (*given during history class*)

Helpful Classroom Materials: Tissue (*boxes not individual package*) Disinfecting Wipes

General Math: 1 spiral notebook with pocket folders, 6" ruler, scientific calculator (preferably Texas instrument), dry erase markers

History 7th: 3 two pocket folders (2 with brads/prongs for 3 hole punched papers) two 70 page spiral notebooks, one just for history and one for citizenship, one highlighter, one red pen for grading papers, one glue stick, pencils or black or blue ink pens for class work

History 8th : One 2" 3 ring binder with pockets, binder dividers-two options: Two 8 tab divider packs or one 16 tab divider pack, pencils, erasers, glue pens, highlighter-any color, loose leaf paper. Optional: pencil pouch

Latin 7th 1 inch 3 ring binder, Dry Erase Markers, eraser for dry erase (old socks work fine), one page protector.

Latin 8th: 1 Pocket Folder; One two subject notebook (preferably with binder holes, so that you can insert in your binder) to be used for Latin specifically, dry erase markers, dry eraser, 2 red pens, 2 blue pens, and 1 small Latin-English/English-Latin dictionary.

Organization and Leadership: 1 spiral notebook, Pencils, Pens, 1 box colored pencils, graphing paper.

Pre-Algebra: 1 spiral notebook with pocket folders, 6" ruler, scientific calculator (preferably Texas instrument), dry erase markers

Reading intensive class 7th and 8th gr: 2" notebook with dividers, pens, pencils and paper, sticky notes, box of tissues or Clorox wipes

Science 7th: 1 composition notebook, 1 two pocket folder

Algebra I: Pencils (traditional or mechanical), Eraser, Bound Lab-Book (preferably with page numbers and grid-lines such as graph paper), **THICK** Dry Erase Markers (will be used by students daily all year), Colored Highlighters (at least 4 different colors), Loose Leaf Paper (college ruled NO spiral bound), Ruler, Glue Stick, Disinfectant Wipes, box of Tissues.

Science 8th: Each student: 1 composition notebook - Classroom supply donations for lab stations: colored pencils, rulers, scissors, glue sticks, colored pencils, tissues

An outside reading book should be carried to each class. The teacher will discuss the appropriate use of the book. This can be one from the list of classics, the library or one from home.

On the first day of class, you will be given an agenda that must be kept in your binder and taken to each class every day. Also, each classroom is in need of *tissues* for the runny noses that occur during the year. ***Donations of boxes of tissues are welcomed and needed.***

HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES, ARTS AND SPORTS SUPPLY LIST

Algebra I: 1 Math folder, 1 scientific calculator (graphing calculator also works), pencils, 1 red or colored pen, 1 highlighter, 1 whiteboard marker, Optional supplies: Tissues, Hand Sanitizer

Algebra II: A calculator is required. Texas Instruments models: 83, 84, or Inspire are strongly recommended. All instruction will be given in class using the TI-Inspire calculator. **Thick white board markers (will use daily all year)**. Spiral bound notebook dedicated for this class for taking notes. Pencils (traditional or mechanical), Erasers. A box of Kleenex and a package of disinfecting wipes.

DE Anatomy: 1 composition notebook, 1 folder with pockets, blue or black pen, pencils, highlighter, glue sticks.

Biology: required 1 composition notebook, *Optional* but very helpful, dry erase markers, colored pencils or markers. No spiral notebooks allowed.

Honors Biology: 1 composition notebook, 1 folder with pockets, blue or black pen, pencils, and highlighter, glue sticks.

DE Biotechnology: 1 composition notebook, 1 folder with pockets, blue or black pen, pencils, highlighter, glue sticks.

British Literature 11th and 12th grades: 2" binder with dividers, highlighters in three colors, whiteboard marker, free write notebook (either spiral or composition), notecards, sticky notes, pens, pencils, paper, box of tissues or Clorox wipes

Calculus: Students will need a 1.5" or 2" 3 ring binder used only for this course. Additionally, a graphing calculator is essential for this course. Texas Instruments models: 83, 84, or N-Spire are strongly recommended as all instruction will be done using these calculators as models.

Chemistry: Class supplies: Scientific graphing calculator

Optional for in-person class: Smart phone or laptop to use in the classroom.

Items needed at home: Colored pencils, scissors, computer with internet access.

Items to voluntarily bring: colored pencils, glue sticks, sandwich Ziploc bags, unused hair bands, disposable gloves, small disposable dixie cups, tissues

Choir (Junior High and High School): black 3-ring binder 1", pencil

Club Fitness: P.E. uniform or regular Heritage uniform may be worn.

Conceptual science: each scholar will need two composition books or spiral notebooks. (graph paper in at least one of them is preferred); at least two different colors of dry erase markers; and at least two different colors of writing utensils (pen or pencil) for note-taking and correcting peers' work.

Cross Country: Required: Running shoes, 3-5 sets of the school issued uniform, water bottle. Optional: Hat, sunglasses.

Economics: Blue or black pens, pencil with eraser, lined paper, notebook or folder to hold class notes, homework, quizzes, tests and reports.

English – 9th grade:

- 1 1-subject spiral notebook
- 1" 3-ring binder
- 150 sheets of college-ruled notebook paper
- 2 blue or black ink pens
- 1 red pen
- 1 highlighter

English - 10th grade: Each student should have:

- ❖ Pens (Black/Blue)

- ❖ 2 pocket folder with brads
- ❖ 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder with dividers
- ❖ Highlighters (Blue, Pink, Green, Yellow)

English 101/102 and English 110/111

- College-ruled notebook paper
- pens/pencils/highlighters/dry erase markers
- post-it notes

French: Lined paper, binder to save notes in, black or blue and red pens, note cards to make flash cards, dry- erase markers.

Geometry: 1 inch binder for guided notes, Scientific calculator (including sin, cos and tan buttons- TI-30XIIS or TI-30XS is preferred calculator. White board markers (will use daily all year), Red pen, Protractor, ruler and compass, graph paper, highlighters (at least 3 different colors)

Government: Blue or black pens, pencil with eraser, lined paper, notebook or folder to hold class notes, homework, quizzes, tests and reports.

Keyboarding: Earbuds

Organization and Leadership: 1 spiral notebook, pencils, pens, 1 box colored pencils, graphing paper.

Orchestra Ensembles: Instrument, music stand, rosin, shoulder rest for violin & viola players, manuscript paper (available as free pdf online)

Physical Science: Each scholar will need two composition notebooks, two different colors of pen or pencil (for notetaking and checking peers' work); two colors of dry erase markers and a pack of 50 or more index cards that are blank on at least one side.

Physics: Each scholar will need two composition books, at least one of them needs to have graph paper in it); at least two different colors of dry erase markers; a graphing calculator (TI-83 or 84 or Nspire are strongly recommended); two different colors of pen and or pencil for taking notes (and highlighting) and checking peers' work; and a small ruler (preferably transparent).

Piano class: Piano or keyboard, Solo music of choice, manuscript paper (available as free pdf on line)

Pre Calculus: A graphing calculator is essential for this course. Texas Instruments models: 83, 84, or N-spire are strongly recommended as all instruction will be done using these calculators as models. A separate notebook that is used only for math will also be needed.

Rio Salado Math 150 (Algebra II): A graphing calculator is essential for this course. Texas Instruments models: TI- Inspire CX, CAS, or CX CAS are strongly recommended. It is not recommended that any other model of calculator be purchased for this course. **White board markers (will use daily all year).** A box of Kleenex and a package of disinfecting wipes.

Softball: glove, rubber cleat shoes, black softball pants, exercise workout clothes (white T-shirt and shorts/workout pants)

Soccer: shin guards, socks that fit over shin guards, PE Uniforms as required by Heritage, soccer cleats

Spanish 1 and Spanish 2 Honors DE with Senora Luz-Hoxsie -: Notebook, pencil, eraser, set of colored pens for note taking (at least 4 colors), coloring supplies (thin markers or coloring pencils), highlighter.

Spanish1/2/3 with Senor Jewel: 3-ring binder, tabbed dividers (at least 5). Please re-supply your student with white board markers mid-semester.

Swimming: Swimsuit, cap and goggles, towel, mesh swim bag (to store wet items) and fins (optional). PE uniform required by Heritage

Trigonometry: A graphing calculator is essential for this course. Texas Instruments models: 83, 84, or Inspire are strongly recommended. Any other models or brands are ok, but student must be very familiar with all their functions and be able to use them without help. Separate notebook that is used only for Math.

World History: Black or blue and red pens, college ruled lined paper, binder for notes.

Yearbook – camera and flash drive and card reader to upload pictures

Dance: Solid black full-length leggings and either the Heritage PE shirt and/or a Heritage polo.
