

The University of Arizona KEYS Research Internship Program is a unique opportunity for motivated Arizona high school students to spend their summer exploring real-world scientific research on the UA campus.

Students enroll at the University and receive 3 units of Molecular and Cellular Biology.

Students spend their summer working in the laboratory completing research projects.

At the end of the program, students present their research at our very well attended Research Showcase.

There are only two application requirements: the student must be 16 by the start of the program and must be an Arizona resident.

Strong candidates are academically competitive.

We recommend students have completed biology or chemistry before participating in KEYS.

The deadline for applications is December 1, 2019.

The only program costs are for room and board for students from outside of Tucson.

Financial aid is available on a need basis.
