Extracurricular Activity (ECA) Arizona Tax Credit Information

Hello Heritage families!

As your scholar considers participating in one of our upcoming study tours, did you know that the State of Arizona provides an option whereby you and other Arizona residents can help your scholar fund their tour cost through donations that then give the donor a dollar-for-dollar credit on their state income tax return?

Under Arizona law, Arizona tax payers can claim a non-refundable individual tax credit for fees and cash contributions paid to public schools (including charters) in Arizona for the support of extracurricular activities or character education programs.

The credit is equal to the amount of fees paid or amount contributed, dollar-for-dollar, up to \$200 for single or head of household taxpayers, and up to \$400 for married taxpayers that file a joint return. (ARS §43-1089.01)

The state tax credit is available to ALL qualifying individual Arizona state taxpayers. The donor does not need to have a child enrolled at Heritage Academy to take advantage of this state tax credit; as long as the donor is an Arizona resident they can donate.
