

Heritage Academy's 24th Semi-Annual American History Excursion

“Liberty History Tour”

to

Boston, Lexington, Concord, Plymouth, New York City

Sun/Mon, October 8/9 - Saturday, October 14, 2023 - (6 days / 5 nights)

Includes: Airfare, transportation, hotel rooms (quad occupancy), five full breakfasts, five dinners, and all entrance fees.

Scholars are required to pay the full cost of the tour unless they meet the enrollment and grade requirements for a scholarship. Scholars' portion must be paid according to the following schedule:

<u>Date Due:</u>	<u>Amount Due:</u>
21 April 2023	\$800
19 May 2023	\$750
25 August 2023	\$750 (\$175 if on scholarship)
Total scholar portion	\$2,300 (unless on scholarship)

(Less than 4 per room additional per person charges: triple- \$120, double- \$360, single- \$1,040)

There will also be a charge by the airlines for each checked bag

Cancellation schedule as follows: \$250/person non-refundable; 75% refunded >90 days prior to departure; 50% refunded >60 days prior to departure; 25% refunded >30 days prior to departure; no refund <30 days prior to departure.

All scholars must meet the following criteria in order to participate. Open only to 11th and 12th graders. Once scholar has met the requirement in the first sentence below, he/she must choose an option:

No scholar with a D or F at the end of the Spring Semester 2023 or with a major disciplinary referral will be allowed to register for this tour without teacher approval. Scholars who think they may eventually qualify should talk with their teacher chaperone before signing up for the tour and may be placed on an alternate list. Once qualified, scholars will be allowed to register if space is available and all money due to-date must be paid immediately. Payment for this tour will be according to one of two options:

Option 1. Scholars who have not been enrolled at Heritage Academy for the past two consecutive school years, or don't have straight A's on their transcript for all classes taken during that time will pay the full cost of the tour.

Option 2. Scholars who have been enrolled at Heritage Academy for the past two consecutive school years, and have straight A's on their transcript for all classes taken during that time are eligible for an academic scholarship, and will pay 75% of the tour cost.
