

## Heritage Academy's 25th Biennial American History Excursion

# The Independence Tour

**Williamsburg, Virginia | Washington, DC | Philadelphia, Pennsylvania**

Sunday, October 6 – Saturday, October 12, 2024 (6 days / 5 nights)

### Eligibility

This tour is open only to **Heritage Juniors and Seniors**. No scholar with a failing grade (D or F) in any class at the end of the Spring Semester 2024 or with a major disciplinary referral will be allowed to register for this tour without principal approval. Scholars who do not presently qualify but who think they may eventually qualify should speak with the tour lead before registering for the tour and may be placed on an alternate list.

### Tour Fees

The cost of the tour is **\$2,300**. This covers airfare and other transportation, hotel accommodations (four per room), five full breakfasts, five dinners, and all site entrance fees.

Scholars are required to pay the full cost of the tour unless they meet the enrollment and grade requirements for a scholarship. Scholarships covering 25% of the tour fees will be awarded to scholars who have:

- 1) been enrolled at Heritage Academy for two consecutive school years immediately prior to the tour, and
- 2) received straight A's on their transcript for all classes taken at Heritage during those two consecutive years.

Tour fees must be paid according to the following schedule:

### Additional Costs

By default, hotel accommodations will be arranged four per room. If scholars require some other scholar-per-room arrangement, the scholar(s) may be required to cover the following additional costs: (three-per-room: \$120; two-per-room: \$360; single-scholar room: \$1,040).

Scholars will be required to cover the cost of any bags checked with the airline.

### Cancellation

Any cancellations made after an initial payment will incur a \$250-per-scholar non-refundable charge. Any remaining funds will be refunded according to the following schedule:

More than 90 days prior to departure:	75% refund
More than 60 days prior to departure:	50% refund
More than 30 days prior to departure:	25% refund
Less than 30 days prior to departure:	no refund

- Check into your hotel in DC where you will stay for two nights – **Hampton Inn & Suites Falls Church** (or similar)
