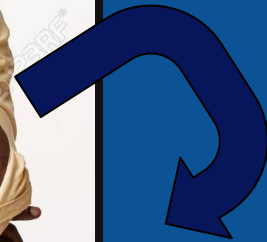
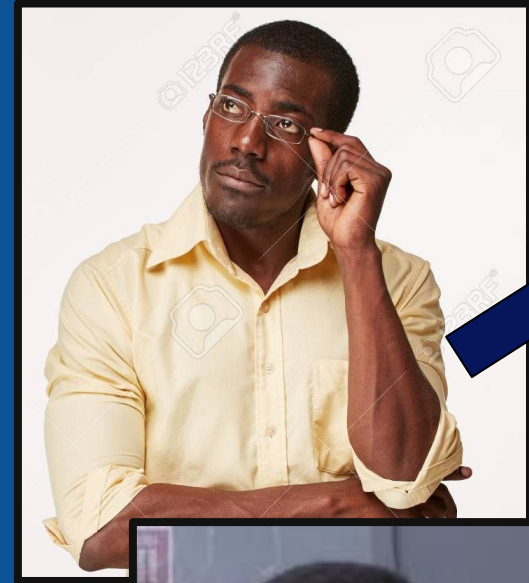

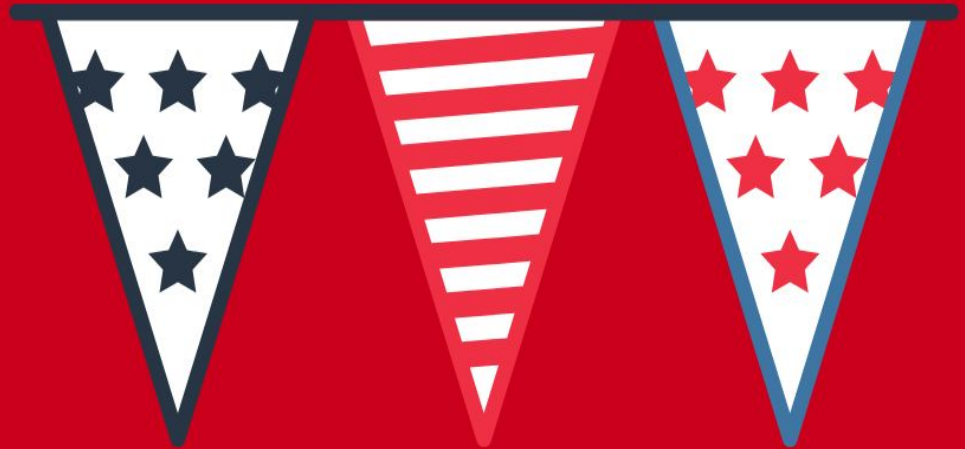
Why Join Scholar Council?

Positions: Student Body President

Must be a senior next year!

- Presides over and conducts ALL scholar council meetings and ensures that the voice of administration, teachers, scholars and all council members are heard
- Serves as a liaison between the administration, faculty and the student body
- Assists with Dollar for Duds and fundraising activities
- Acts as chair of one major activity



Positions: Scholar Body Vice President

Must be a senior next year!

- Assists the President in all he/she does
- Takes over presidential duties in her/his absence
- Acts as chair for one major activity
- Attends and assists with all scholar council activities
- Updates the Music playlist



Positions: Public Relations Officer

Must be a 10th-12th Grade

- Runs all social media accounts
- Works to advertise council events to the school community, PTO, & etc.
- Organizes announcements
- Records SchoCo Videos
- Assists at all events



Positions: Secretary/Treasurer

Must be 10-12 grader next year!



- Manages and Oversees the Budget
- Take notes every meeting
- Participate in all SchoCo Events!

Senior Class President (12th)

Senior Class Representative/ Senior Class President

- Coordinates Homecoming activities with alumni
- Acts as chair for one major activity
- Plans all senior meetings and any additional senior events for life
- Gets senior shirts and other clothing by the end of the first semester
- Coordinates senior trip (optional, based on need)



Positions: Class Representatives

Must be going into represented grade!

Other Class Representatives

- Surveys and communicates with fellow class scholars to obtain ideas and encourage participation in scholar council activities!
- Represents the ideas of her/his class appropriately in scholar council meetings
- Attends and assists with all scholar council activities

- Surveys and communicates with fellow class scholars to obtain ideas and encourage participation in scholar council activities.
- Represents the ideas of her/his class appropriately in scholar council meetings
- Attends and assists with all scholar council activities
