



Athletic Eligibility Policy

- 1. Grade checks will be conducted every two weeks on Tuesdays.**
- 2. To maintain athletic eligibility, scholars must be passing all classes with a minimum grade of 70%.**
- 3. First Grade Check (Warning):**

If a scholar appears on the grade check list for the first time, they will receive a warning. The scholar will have two weeks to raise all grades to 70% or higher.
- 4. Second Consecutive Grade Check (Competition Ineligibility):**

If a scholar appears on the grade check list for a second consecutive grade check, they will be ineligible to participate in competitions until the next grade check. The scholar may continue to attend and participate in team practices during this time.
- 5. Third Consecutive Grade Check (Full Athletic Ineligibility):**

If a scholar appears on the grade check list for a third consecutive grade check, they will be ineligible to participate in both competitions and practices. In addition, the scholar may be removed from their sports class and assigned to a study hall until academic eligibility is restored.
- 6. Restoring Eligibility:**

Eligibility will be reinstated once the scholar achieves a minimum grade of 70% in all classes at an official bi-weekly grade check.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that academics remain the primary focus while providing scholars with opportunities to participate in athletics.
